

LIVING COST

Living cost in most of the cities varies from **\$500 to \$1000 per month.**

The requirements vary along with the programs and levels. In general, following requirements—

Bachelors

50% and above for humanities stream in class XIIth
55%-65% and above for Science/ Commerce stream in class XIIth

Certificates / Diploma programs

50% and above in class XIIth

PG Certificates / PG Diploma programs

55% and above in Bachelors degree.

Masters

55% and above in Bachelor's degree.

MBA

55%- 65% and above in Bachelor, Preferably with relevant work-ex.

Language requirement

In addition to the above requirements, students from India are required to meet the minimum language requirements, set for the program - 6.5 (Overall) with no band less than 6.0.

TIP- In case the student is unable to meet these requirements directly, he can secure admission via pathway program.

IMPORTANT EXAMS

GENERAL EXAMS

GMAT –Max score 800.

GMAT is conducted by Pearson -vue worldwide. GMAT score is usually required for MBA and other business related education at Master's level. It measures student in three broad areas- Quant, Verbal and Reasoning. The mathematics is upto 10th standard but quite tricky, so can't be taken for granted. The verbal section mainly tests the reading comprehension skills and grammar of the test taker.

GRE –Max score 340.

GRE is another Important test required by graduate schools to pursue Masters programs. Just like GMAT, GRE also measures the student's capabilities in three broad areas- Quant, Verbal and Reasoning. The mathematics is upto 10th standard but quite tricky. The verbal section directly tests the vocabulary and reading comprehension skills of the test taker.

Repetition of Exams-You can give GMAT any number of times, subject to 5 times a year and a gap of 30 days between two tests. The same set of rules apply to GRE as well.

Ideal preparatory duration-Usually 4 to 6 months of preparation is advisable for any of these exams.

Ideal test time- If your target program, requires either of the GRE or GMAT and if you are aiming the FALL (Sept) intake, you should appear for these exams by Oct- Nov of the previous year.

For eg- if you want to target Fall 2019 session, take your exam before Oct-Nov of 2018.

Tip -Nowadays, most business schools are also accepting GRE scores in lieu of GMAT for MBA and other B-school programs BUT GMAT is not acceptable in graduate schools in lieu of the GRE.

LANGUAGE EXAMS

IELTS : Max score - 9 Bands | Paper Based Exam

TOEFL: Max score –120 | Computer Based Exam

IELTS and TOEFL both are standardized language tests, which test your English proficiency skills in the four modules – Speaking / Listening / Reading and Writing. The main difference between them is the format in which they are conducted.

IELTS is a paper based test, where you will use pen and paper to register your answers and speaking session would be interaction with examiner. On the contrary, TOEFL is a completely Computer based test, all the section including speaking has to be done on computer. Students are free to choose any of these exams based on their convenience. Student need to note that there are two types of IELTS exam – IELTS Academic and IELTS General. **For all study abroad purposes, student need to take IELTS ACADEMIC exam and NOT IELTS General.**

Repetition of exams- IELTS / TOEFL can be taken unlimited number of times. You can retake the exam, once your result has been declared.

Ideal preparatory duration – Usually 2 to 4 months of preparation is advisable for any of these exams, depending on an Individual's proficiency in English language .

Ideal test time- You should appear for these exams atleast 15 days before the application deadline of your target program. Ideally you should take it 2-3 months in advance, so that in case your score fall short of the requirement, you still got some time to retake and obtain better grades.

Minimum requirements-Although the score requirement varies with programs & universities but still the basic requirement for most are :

IELTS – 6.5 (Overall) / 6.0 (No section less than 6.0)
TOEFL - 80 (Overall) / 17 (No section less than 17)

***Pls note - It is important to note that these numbers are just for reference purpose, the actual numbers may differ from university to university and program to program.**

IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS

SOP: Statement of Purpose

A SOP is your personal statement about who you are, what has influenced your career path so far, your professional interests and where you plan to go from here. The SOP is your chance to talk directly to the admissions committee. To make you stand out from among a multitude of similarly qualified candidates. To convince the committee that you have the spark, the thirst for knowledge that could add value to your class. Writing your admissions essays or Statement of Purpose, is a long and intensive process – ten to twelve drafts over a two-month period are fairly common. It is necessary to put in this hard work to come up with an essay that is uniquely yourself, and a compelling read which convinces the admissions committee that you are the right candidate for their school.

LOR: Letter of recommendation

LOR is a recommendation letter written by a third party describing the qualities and capabilities of the prospective student. This letter is used by the admission committee to gauge the candidature of the candidate from the eyes of the recommender and judge that prospective student's ability to perform a particular task or function. These letters can be taken from your college professor, your project guide/ mentor. If you are working then you can take your professional LOR from your manager / team leader. If you are a professional or businessman then probably you can take a LOR from your clients or suppliers etc.

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

For making an Application, usually the following documents are required-

- Notarized copies of mark sheets - X, XII and Bachelor's degree (For PG courses)
- IELTS / TOEFL score reports
- Two to Three, Recommendation letters (Academic / Professional)
- Statement of Purpose (SOP)
- Resume
- GMAT / GRE score reports (if Reqd)
- Portfolio (Art & Design courses /Creative programs)
- Others (Certificates / achievements and extracurricular activities)
- Proof of funds
- Work- ex certificates, Salary slips etc.

APPLYING FOR VISA

Following are the main documents needed to file the student visa -

- Offer letter from university: You must include the original letter with your study permit application.
- Confirmation of Enrollment: You must include Confirmation of Enrollment (COE) from your Australian university/ college.
- Proof of Financial support: You must provide adequate funds to support one year study and living expenses. For meeting living expenses- GIC certificates are most preferred.
- Transcripts, diplomas, degrees, or certificates: Attested copies of all these from all the schools / colleges that you have attended.
- GRE/ GMAT test scores
- IELTS (Academic) / TOEFL test scores



WORK

In Australia your work visa is dependent upon your intended study credentials.

Bachelor / Master degree (Non- thesis)

Work visa = 2 years

Master degree (Research) / PHD

Work visa = 3to 4 years

All other study programs

Work visa = 1.5 years

Part time work

20 hrs/wk & 40 hrs/wk during Holidays.

Work Rights for Spouse
